The Rock Dell Town Board met Monday, August 8, 2022 at 7:00pm at the Rock Dell Town Hall. Those officers attending were Supervisors Betsy Kleinwort, Terry King and Mike Meyers, Treasurer Dave Siljenberg and Clerk Brenda Lindquist. Also attending Bill Pirkl, Avia Torkelson and Brad Mattison. Chairman Terry King called the meeting to order.

Brenda read the minutes of the July meeting. The minutes were approved as read. Dave gave the treasurer's report. Income for the month was \$27.85 bank interest and \$35,844.57 2nd Half ARPA, 92,096.08 2nd half Property Tax and \$3,455.00 Market Value. Checks written in the amount of \$60,854.59. Ending balance of \$242,111.27. Treasurer's report approved as given.

ARPA funds was discussed. Mike Meyers made a motion, seconded by Betsy Kleinwort to move \$71,689.17 into its own fund named Covid fund; motion carried with 3 yea votes.

Bill Pirkl introduced himself as running for County Commissioner.

Avia Torkelson gave a report on the county law enforcement. One theft and an injury accident.

Safety cones was discussed. We need to have safety cones in case a road needs to be marked. Betsy Kleinwort made a motion, seconded by Mike Meyers to purchase 9 cones; motion carried with 3 yea votes.

80th Ave south of hwy 30 has washed out spots. 90th Ave north of hwy 30 has a culvert that needs to be replaced.

Claims reviewed. Mike Meyers made a motion, seconded by Betsy Kleinwort to pay all claims; motion carried with 3 yea votes. Checks were signed. Meeting adjourned.
